8:15 AM		Flag Ceremony - SCs, Fantastics, STARs & Stewards do the flag ceremony this morning.
		Continue the Sunday training schedule with the counselors!

Time:	Scheduled Event:	Responsibility:
6:15 - 7:15		Showers (Men in Men's Shower House & Women in Women's Shower House)
7:30 AM	Meeting	Meet in the staff room.
8:15 AM	Flag Ceremony	SCs do flag with other staff
8:30 AM	Breakfast	One SC per table sitting with the counselors
9:30 AM		Are the counselors pumped? Keep encouraging them to focus on their kids coming to camp. Is the Welcome Song ready?
10:05 AM	Here They Come!	Participate in singing the Welcome Song to the 6th graders with the counselors. When all the students have gone to the bowl participate responsibly in unloading students' luggage from buses. When finished the Stewards will lead everyone to the campfire bowl. Go as a group!
	Opening Assembly	Sit together as SCs somewhere behind groups of students during the orientation.
	Students meet their counselors	When your areas cabins are called stand up in front with your STAR to greet counselors and kids. Go with the last group of students on their tour of camp and then to the lodge to get their lunches. Get your lunch and eat with one of your cabins of students and counselor. As soon as you are finished eating go with the first group of students to your living area. Stay there as the kids move in and assist counselors and kids in any way possible.
2:30 - 3:45	Recreation	Go to recreation with the campers and counselors from your living area. Participate with them in recreation being a wonderful role model!
3:45		Walk with the last cabin group from recreation to the lodge. You can go into the meeting room and wait for the meeting to begin. Don't forget your coat and flashlight!

4:10	Staff Meeting	Participate in the staff meeting.
5:10	Flag Duty	<p>Prepare to be the flag color guard with counselors who sign up. Be very quiet and still as soon as the flag line starts moving from the parking lot.</p> <p>Whoever is shouting the commands should face those assembled and speak slowly and loud. This could be a counselor or SC.</p>
	After flag	<p>Line up at your assigned door to enter the dining hall. This door is your assigned door every meal.</p> <p>Students line up in two lines. Counselors and SCs stand outside those lines quietly visiting with students. Spread out up and down the line. Do NOT visit with other counselors.</p> <p>When the Steward opens the dining hall door counselors and SCs go in first in two lines before the kids. Go to your assigned table.</p>
5:40 - 6:50 PM	Supper	Stay at your assigned table quietly visiting with those at your table. NEVER during the week do you stand up and visit with others. You may sign up to lead songs at meals etc., but not just roam the dining hall unless you've been given that duty.
	Dismissal from Supper	<p>Immediately go out to the parking lot south of the lodge. Several ladies supervise around ladies OWARIIs, several men supervise around men's OWARIIs, others be in cabin sign area and parking area.</p> <p>Keep kids walking and calm with flashlights out of other's faces. Keep kids and their counselors together at all times.</p> <p>Everyone will line up in a line just like the flag line in the same location.</p>
7:15 PM	Find the Staff	After staff have handed out the Find the Staff papers go to your assigned Find the Staff location to participate. Be very kind to the kids and counselors. Smile a lot. Engage the kids in kind conversations.
7:45	Campfire	<p>As Find the Staff ends, walk with one of your area cabin groups . . . one that needs your presence . . . to the campfire bowl.</p> <p>You can sit as a group of SCs at the campfire . . . somewhere in a row right behind the students.</p> <p>Participate in campfire.</p>
	Campfire dismissal	<p>As the last group from your living area leaves the campfire bowl, walk with them to your area.</p> <p>Gently assist in having counselors OWARII their kids and get them into bed. Hopefully you've encouraged the counselors to each stay in their cabin quietly visiting with their kids, reading a book or doing some kind of quiet discussion for 30 minutes. You build the campfire for the counselors.</p> <p>If kids' lights go on after lights out for no legitimate reason simply peacefully take the flashlight away . . . later put the flashlight on the student's shelf before you go to bed.</p>

	Counselor Campfire	Participate in the discussion at the campfire. This is NOT a time to discuss anything inappropriate. Do NOT share any personal drinking, sexual, resisting authority kind of information. The best thing you can do for most of the discussion is be a good listener with your eyes and attention directed to who is speaking as well as using your ears.
10:55 PM	Bedtime!	Make sure the counselors go to bed now, then get to bed yourself!
During the night		If there is an emergency, turn on your radio and call out on channel #1! If you get no response, wake up two counselors. Take one counselor with you while the other one remains awake. Men go to the Little Lodge at the end of Memory Lane into the main room to get help. Raise your voice and call out for the Night Check people. Women go to the Health Room in Discovery Lodge to get help. Remember to be very calm!!! Do not wake up students during any emergency.
<i>Tuesday - Thursday</i>		
6:15 AM		Rise and Shine! Make sure all cabin groups are up and kids are brushing teeth and washing faces and hands!
6:45 AM		Help cabin groups who have work duties leave on time. Remember to be the last one out of the area in order to make sure everyone has left.
7:15 AM		Prepare to hand out during packs to counselors and Happy Pills to adult staff including each other. You will eat at a table with the campers and counselors.
		Give a YO! your camp radio. It will be returned this evening.
8:15 AM		SCs work together to wash the breakfast dishes! This has turned out to be one of the most fun things in camp!
10:00 AM	SC Meeting	Meet with a YO! in the staff meeting room to talk about your upcoming day until tomorrow at this time! When the meeting is finished ask a YO! what else needs done and practice any skit, run on or cheer you will be doing soon.
11:30 AM		There may be a need for you to help in some way with lunch. Check with the YO! in charge of the dining hall at lunch to see if you can help in any way. Otherwise you will be outside one of the dining hall doors checking in with and encouraging campers and counselors. You enter the dining hall last. You eat at a table with the campers and counselors.
12:15 PM		Attend and participate in the daily meeting of counselors and staff.
2:15 PM		Meet at cabin signs to help the campers meet up with their counselors and solve any problems that arise. Then go to the recreation area that your cabin area is at. Participate with your counselors and kids from your area.
3:45ish		When recreation ends immediately go to your assigned living area for cabin time. You encourage campers and counselors to quietly cooperate with each other in planned and unplanned activities. You make sure cabins leave on time for showers and take a few minutes to take your shower as well as help supervise cabins that are the most unruly and help counselors with difficult situations.

5:15 PM		Help cabin groups who have work duties leave on time. You should be the last person leaving your area before dinner.
5:45 PM		There may be a need for you to help in some way with dinner. Check with the Stewards to see if you can help in any way. Otherwise you will be outside one of the dining hall doors checking in with and encouraging campers and counselors. Enter the dining hall last. You eat at a table with the campers and counselors.
		Get your radio from a YO! for use this evening. Remember to leave your radio off unless you need to make an emergency call!
6:45 PM		Supervise OWARII use, men near the boys' OWARII's and women near the girls' OWARII's. Don't bunch up together with other SCs.
7:00ish		Participate in flag! (Times actually vary during the week.)
7:30 PM		Participate in campfire! (Times actually vary during the week.)
8:45ish PM		Leave for your cabin area with the last group of campers and their counselor from your living area headed that way. You may be needed to supervise the OWARII, help with active campers, read a book, sing a quiet song to a cabin etc. When you are finished with those types of things, build the campfire in preparation for the Counselors' Go'Round.
9:20ish PM		Munch snacks and participate in the Counselor Go'Round.
10:55 PM	Bedtime!	Make sure the counselors go to bed now, then get to bed yourself!
During the night		If there is an emergency, turn on your radio and call out on channel #1! If you get no response, wake up two counselors. Take one counselor with you while the other one remains awake. Men go to the Little Lodge at the end of Memory Lane into the main room to get help. Raise your voice and call out for the Night Check people. Women go to the Health Room in Discovery Lodge to get help.
